

Remote Learning

As I'm sure you will all agree, children have missed out on a lot of teaching and learning over the past few months and as we continue with our 'new normal', there may be times where your child/children complete their learning at home. Where possible, the teachers will plan for the same content to be delivered both remotely and in school to ensure there are minimal gaps in the children's knowledge. If your child/household is self-isolating, you should access our remote learning through the Home Learning tab on our website. Guidance on how to access the remote learning can be found on our website too. Our staff will upload the work over different points in the week but you will always be able to access the work for each day by 8:30am.

If you have a child in **KS1**, the learning uploaded for the week will be:

- Phonics slides (guidance on how to teach this will also be in the folder)
- An SFA text with questions for 3 days
- A link to a story via YouTube with some questions for the children once the story has finished
- A writing task (to be completed over 2 days)
- Maths slides and/or activities- these may be a link to Oak Academy. Oak Academy provides online lessons for children with a qualified teacher narrating the lesson.
- Slides and/or activities that link in to the wider curriculum topics that the children will be learning about in school.

If you have a child in **KS2**, the learning uploaded for the week will be:

- 3 days of comprehension
- A writing task (to be completed over 2 days)
- Spelling and grammar work
- Maths slides and/or activities- these may be a link to Oak Academy. Oak Academy provides online lessons for children with a qualified teacher narrating the lesson.
- Slides and/or activities that link in to the wider curriculum topics that the children will be learning about in school.

We expect the children to complete this work where possible to ensure they are still learning the same skills and topics as those who are in school. If you have any difficulty accessing this work, please inform a member of SLT.

We are currently in the processes of creating our google classrooms which will be used to upload, organise and manage our remote learning. You will receive information on this once we are up and running!
